Questions

There was a crowd of Jews following Jesus on the way to celebrate Passover. Based on their intended destination and intent to celebrate a religious feast, what can we safely assume about the crowd as a whole? Why do you think they 'shushed' the blind men?

The sermon spoke of two types of vision problem: spiritual blindness and physical blindness. What similarities and/or differences do you identify between the two? How would you describe spiritual blindness?

Have you ever been desperate for God (or seen someone that was) to the point that you or they didn't care what others said or did in response? Is it possible that we are in a desperate state without realizing it?

Jesus was on his way to celebrate Passover (something very important to him) and still stopped to help these two men. What does this tell us about the character of Jesus? What do you think we can learn from this example?

Apply SOAP (Scripture, Observation, Application, Prayer) to:

Isaiah 35:5-6 (NLT)

And when he comes, he will open the eyes of the blind and unplug the ears of the deaf. The lame will leap like a deer, and those who cannot speak will sing for joy! Springs will gush forth in the wilderness, and streams will water the wasteland.
